Children benefit from

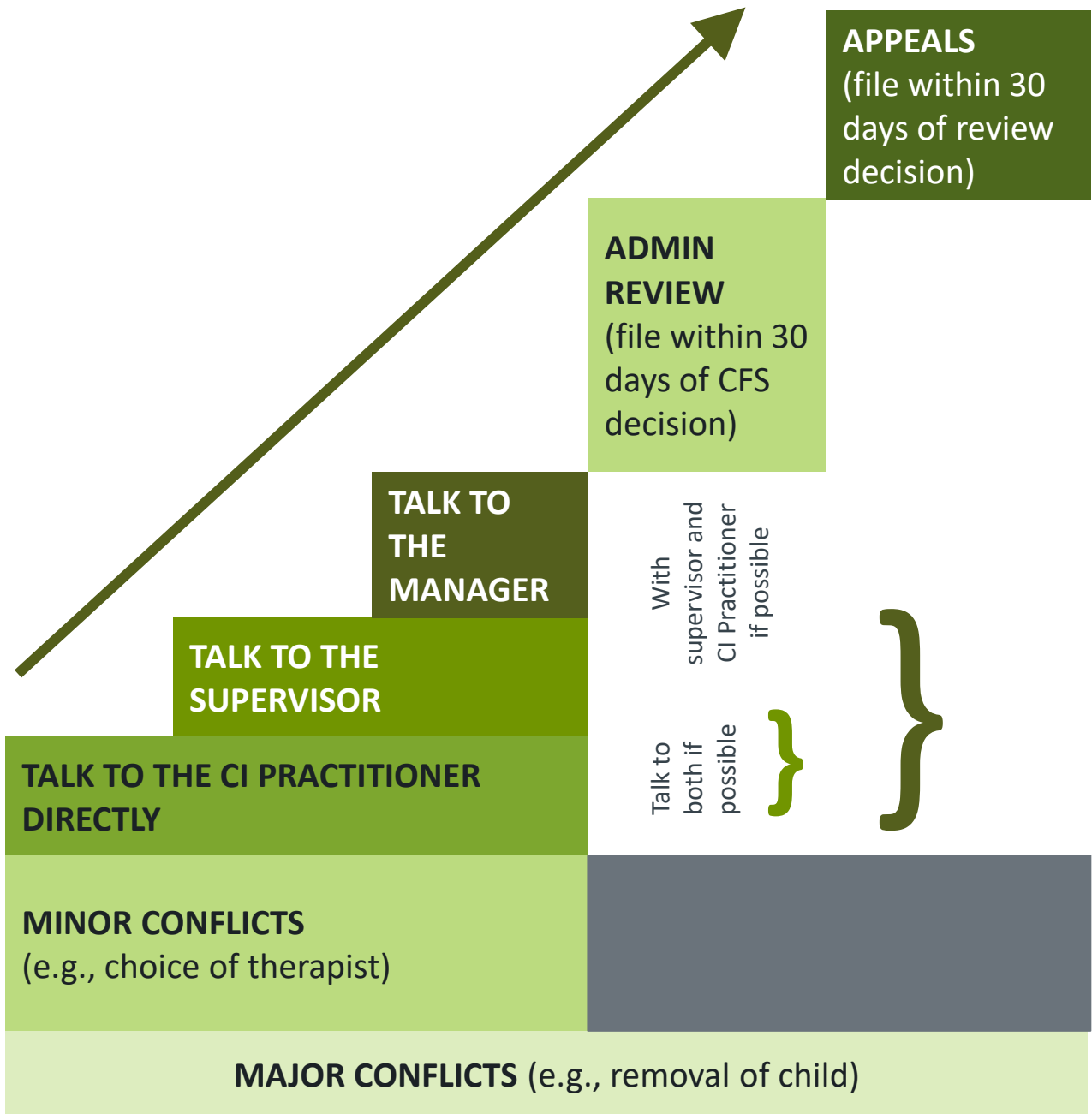
- a) Lasting relationships with family, friends, caregivers and other people who they have formed a connection with.

Indigenous peoples should be involved in the planning and decisions impacting their families and children and providing the services that follow.

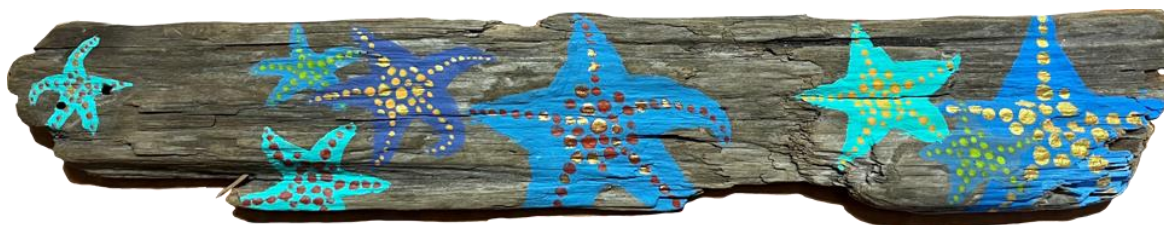

Legislation, Regulations, and Policies

Name and Link	Description
Child, Youth and Family Enhancement Act (CYFEA)	Provides authority for Child and Youth Services to provide services in support of children who are abused, neglected or otherwise in need of intervention.
Enhancement Policy Manual	Contains policies and procedures that direct staff when delivering services under the <i>Child, Youth and Family Enhancement Act</i> . The policies provide direction and procedures for most common situations.
Residential Facilities Licensing Regulation	Provides directions on conditions for licensing a foster home or child and youth facilities and provides information regarding maximum number of foster children that may reside in a licensed foster home, emergency procedures, and records.

Kinship Care Handbook: A Toolkit for Kinship Caregivers	Provides information on practical everyday issues related to kinship care. The handbook covers information on kinship care support, explain policy, and provide facts and material on other program areas.
